**5 Vocational training topics for 100** vulnerable beneficiaries in Marea subdistrict.

Training Topics: Women Tailoring, Women Hairdressing, Mobile Maintenance, Men Tailoring, and Food Industry.

**Business management training of** five days each for the successful applicants after the SMEs training, each participant submitted a business plan which were evaluated by a formed committee for this purpose.

Each successful business plan with the highest scores were sup ported with cash grants of 1200\$ for the first 78 best plans to be paid in three tranches.

## Outcomes

Community resilience strengthened, and socio-economic vulnerabilities of communities affected by the COVID-19 pandemic and economic deterioration reduced through supporting livelihoods in northern Aleppo.

100 male and female beneficiaries from IDPs/host communities have increased ability to secure sustainable livelihood opportunities as a result of increased knowledge and skills through attending vocational training.
